

# **GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS – D+ CHALLENGE**

1 – 3 : **Introduction and rules**

4 – 7 : **registration and fees**

8 – 10 : **data protection and image rights**

11 – 13 : **health and safety**

14 – 16 : **legal responsibility**

## **GENERAL**

1. These terms and conditions form an integral part of the contract between the organiser and the participant. The organiser reserves the right to exclude any participant who fails to comply with the rules.

## **THE CHALLENGE**

2. The event (hereinafter referred to as “challenge,” “race,” “event”) is intended to be challenging and unifying. Participants agree to be present at the starting line for the start and to follow the intended route.

3. Pets are not allowed at the event (this can be discussed with the organizer in advance by email).

## **REGISTRATIONS AND FEES**

4. On-site registration is possible.

5. The organizer reserves the right to accept or refuse a registration in accordance with the aims of the race and the participation limits.

6. The organizer reserves the right, at any time, to disqualify participants if they have provided incorrect information regarding their personal data at the time of registration.

7. There are no registration or participation fees for participants.

## **DATA PROTECTION**

8. Contact data collected is used only to manage registrations and to send information to runners about the race. Data is kept:

- Only up to 1 month after the race in order to contact participants for a survey.
- If consent is given at the time of registration or later on, indefinitely (until revoked by the participant) to share news about Happy Run Club activities.

9. Photos and video recordings made during the race may be used, without any right to financial compensation, on social networks, on television, on the internet, on merchandising, in our own advertising materials, magazines or books.

10. Participants who do not wish to be photographed or videotaped should inform the organisers of this in advance of the event via the contact email or on the day of the event.

## **HEALTH AND SAFETY**

11. By registering, participants confirm that, on the date of the event, they will be well trained for the race and in good physical condition.

12. If you feel ill or feverish in the days leading up to the event, or on the day of the event, you should not take part. We recommend that you drink enough fluids during and after the race. In the event of breathlessness, dizziness, exhaustion, severe pain or other symptoms, the participant should stop running. Medical staff present at the event may withdraw runners from the race at any time if they observe any health problems.

13. The organiser reserves the right to exclude any participant or spectator from the race venue in response to behaviour deemed dangerous or inappropriate.

## **LIABILITY**

14. The organiser and its representatives accept no liability for any risks to runners, particularly those relating to health. It is the responsibility of each participant to start the race in good health and well trained. Insurance remains the responsibility of the participant.

15. The organiser declines all responsibility towards spectators and third parties.

16. The organiser declines all responsibility in the event of accident, damage or theft during the event.

## **ORGANISATION**

17. The event organiser is the Happy Run Club, an association set up in 2024.
18. The place of jurisdiction is Lausanne.
19. The organiser reserves the right to make changes.
